Vice Chairman Gabor referred to the March 12, 2020, Governor Baker Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law, to enable public bodies to carry out their responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations regarding social distancing as fully stated on the agenda. As further explained on the agenda, the Executive Order relieves public bodies from the requirement in the Open Meeting Law that meetings be conducted in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, provided that the public body makes provision to ensure public access to the deliberations of the public body through adequate, alternative means. On March 29, 2023, Governor Healy signed into law An Act Relative to Extending Certain State of Emergency Accommodations, which includes an extension of the temporary provisions regarding remote meetings from March 31, 2023, to March 31, 2025.

Vice Chairman Gabor advised that there was no quorum present. He stated that this is an informational discussion only and that no votes will be taken.

Vice Chairman Gabor announced that this discussion is being recorded and will be uploaded to the Town's YouTube channel.

The Selectmen stood and took the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board recognized and congratulated retired fire fighters Lieutenant Henry Fontaine, Lieutenant Joseph Motrucinski and Fire Fighter Ronald Lamontagne and thanked them for their many years of service and
