## PRESS RELEASE

On August 6, 2013 Webster Police located a male subject on Wall Street that appeared to have been the victim of an assault and battery. The victim stated he was beaten by two males who allegedly stole his watch, a gold chain and keys to his vehicle. One assailant was identified as Trent D. Nicholopoulos, DOB 01/13/90, of 43 Hillside Ave. Webster, MA. A warrant was issued and Mr. Nicholopoulos was arrested and charged with Assault to commit a felony, Unarmed Robbery, and Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon. At the time of his arrest, Mr. Nicholopoulos was out on bail in an unrelated armed robbery, Superior Court Case.

Webster Detectives interviewed the victim and learned a substantial amount of money was stolen. Further investigation revealed the suspects father, David J. Nicholopoulos, ( a retired Webster Police Officer) DOB 03/10/56, of 43 Hillside Ave. had contacted the victim on behalf of his son Trent who was in jail. David Nicholopolous met the victim in order to pay back some of the stolen money in exchange for the victim telling the court he could not identify his assailants.

On 09/18/13 Webster Police executed a search warrant at 43 Hillside Avenue in Webster for the purpose of seizing evidence. David J. Nicholopoulos was arrested and charged with Witness Interference, Conspiracy, and Knowingly receiving stolen property. David Nicholopoulos is currently being held on \$5,000.00 cash bail.

The investigation is on-going.
