Sealed bids for construction services will be received by the Department of Public Works, for the Town of Webster, Massachusetts, at the Office of the Highway Superintendent 23 Cudworth Road, Webster, Massachusetts 01570, until 2:00 PM, Wednesday, June 27, 2012, and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids will be for the Town requirements in pavement management services and materials for various amounts in varying locations throughout the Town as determined by the Department of Public Works. The following items are advertised for bidders:

Placement of hot mix asphalt with tack coat; pulverize and reshape existing bituminous concrete pavement; catch basins, manholes and water gates remodel or adjust to grade; liquid asphalt stone and rubber in place; pavement milling of bituminous concrete; crack sealing; micro-surfacing with crack sealing; liquid asphalt chip seal in place; Hot-in-Place Recycling of bituminous concrete and full-depth reclamation with cement.

All items bid are for varying amounts, varying locations, and should include F.O.B., delivered, in place, installed, provided and available, whichever the case may be.

Specifications and bid forms may be obtained at the Office of the Highway Superintendent, weekdays from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM beginning on Wednesday, June 6, 2012, upon payment of a deposit of \$25.00 per set, payable to the "Town of Webster", which deposit shall be refunded provided the specifications are returned in good and unmarked condition within (10) days after the bid opening. Contract documents will not be issued via mail, courier, etc. All bids are to become effective July 2, 2012 and remain in effect until June 30, 2013.

All materials and workmanship shall be in accordance with the Town of Webster, Office of Department of Public Works' Specifications for Pavement Management Materials and Services.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts Prevailing Wages will apply to this contract.

Contractors must be MassDOT pre-qualified to bid on this contract.

Attention of the bidder is called to the requirements of the minimum wage rates to be paid where applicable. Bids shall be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. The Department of Public Works' agents for the Town of Webster shall have the authority to reject any or all bids, in whole or in part, and accept the bid deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Webster.
