To further reduce waste and put forth more efforts to recycle we will continue to:

- Collect clothing and fabric in recycling containers as is the current arrangement
- Emphasize the composting of food scraps in a backyard composter and instruct residents to either make their own or they can purchase one at the Webster Highway Department.

**NO LIQUIDS Are Accepted !** - This includes paint, drywall compound, foundation sealer, cooking oil, anti-freeze, flammables as motor oil, gasoline, kerosene, insecticides, fertilizers, etc.

These items should be returned to the place where the new product was purchased.

Magazines, catalogs  
Telephone/Soft Cover Books  
Junk Mail/Envelopes  
Paper  
Paperboard  
Milk/Juice Cartons  
Brown Paper Bags  
Plastic Food & Beverage Containers Marked # 1-7  
Soda/Juice/Water Bottles (Glass or Plastic)  
Milk Jugs, Bleach/Detergent, Shampoo Bottles  
Food Containers (Cottage cheese/margarine/yogurt)  
Glass Bottles/Jars (any color)  
Aluminum (Pie plates/trays/foil)

### **What NOT to include:**

No Plastic Bags (or recyclables in Plastic Bags)  
No Unmarked plastics (laundry baskets/chairs/toys)  
No Windows/Light Bulbs  
No Dishes, No Pyrex, No Ceramics  
No Foam Packing, No Styrofoam  
No Aerosol Cans (paint hairspray/cleaners)  
No Recyclables Containing Food Waste  
No Used Tissues, Paper Towels, or Paper Plates

Newspaper and Corrugated will be collected in separate containers
