

**Town Warrant
Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

To either of the constables of the Town of Webster in the county aforesaid **Greetings:**

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required and directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Webster aforesaid who are qualified to vote in Elections and Town Affairs to meet in the Auditorium (so called) Municipal Building, 350 Main Street, in said Webster on Monday, March 11th 2013 at seven o'clock in the forenoon then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

Article 1: Shall the Town of Webster be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two-and-one half, so called, the amounts required to pay for the Town's allocable share of the bond issued by the Southern Worcester County Regional Vocational School District for the purpose of paying costs of designing, constructing, originally equipping and furnishing an addition to and renovation of the Bay Path Regional Vocational Technical High school, located at 57 Old Muggett Hill Road, Charlton, including the payment of all costs incidental or related there to?

All polls close at eight o'clock in the evening.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by publishing an attested copy therefore in a newspaper published within the Town of Webster at least seven days preceding the meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of holding said meeting.
