NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Webster Office of Community Development (OCD) will hold a public hearing on Monday, June 16, 2025, at 6:00 P.M. on behalf of the Board of Selectmen. The hearing's purpose is to discuss a program amendment to the Town's FY 2025 Mini-Entitlement (ME) Massachusetts Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The OCD is seeking input on the reprogramming of approximately \$280,000 in excess funds under its FY 2025 ME grant to rebuild sidewalks in the town's Golden Heights housing complex or pursue the implementation of other eligible project(s).

The public hearing will also include a discussion of the Town's unmet housing and community development needs as described in its Community Development Strategy (CDS), and the limits and possible expansion of the Webster Center CDBG Target Area. The CDS cites possible actions to address a broad range of the town's needs. The program amendment that is under consideration for the FY2025 grant requires the Town to adjust the borders of the Webster Center CDBG Target Area if it wants to add an activity at Golden Heights.

The hearing will be held in the Webster Town Hall, Board of Selectmen's Office, 350 Main Street, Webster. Any person or organization wishing to be heard will be afforded an opportunity to do so. Comments and/or suggestions regarding the proposed program amendment to Webster's FY 2025 grant or the Webster Community Development Strategy may be made at the hearing, or in writing to the Webster OCD, Webster Town Hall, 350 Main Street, Webster, MA 01570.

The Town encourages a broad spectrum of participation by residents and other interested parties, to better understand and serve the community's needs. The hearing location is accessible to persons with physical disabilities.
