NEW BOARD BUSINESS

Public Hearing – variance for septic system 2 Sylvester Drive

The Health Director explained to the Board that a new septic system will be installed and it is within 100ft of a neighboring property, which requires the Board of Health to hold a Public Hearing. The Health Director suggested that the Board enforces a baseline Title V test from the installer prior to the installation and then a reasonable amount of time after the installation. The biggest concern from the Health Director is the slope of the property leading down to the well from the septic system. After much discussion between the Board members a determination was made.
