Organizations, bands, and marching units are asked to assemble near Zmetra's Memorials, at the intersection of Route 12 and Worcester Road in Webster, at 10:00 AM, where members of the Parade Marshalls will be on hand to coordinate the "Order of March" of all units.

THE PARADE WILL FORM NEAR THE ENTRANCE TO ST. ANTHONY CEMETERY IN WEBSTER AND WILL PROCEED PROMPTLY AT 11:00 AM TO WEBSTER TOWN HALL PLAZA FOR EXERCISES AT THE VETERANS COURT OF HONOR
