Eligibility Criteria & Nomination Guidelines

Eligibility:

Candidates must be residents of the Town of Webster or have made a significant and demonstrable positive impact on the natural resources within the Webster community.

Nomination Requirements:

Nominations must include the following information:

1. Nominator Information:

- Full Name
- Address
- Email Address
- Phone Number

2. Nominee Information:

- Full Name of Nominee (or Group Name)
- Email Address of Nominee (or Group Address)
- Phone Number of Nominee (or Group Phone)

3. Nomination Summary:

- A detailed written summary outlining the nominee's (or group's) exceptional contributions to the protection and enhancement of Webster's natural resources.
- Please provide specific examples of their actions, achievements, and the positive impact they have had on the environment within the Webster community, including relevant timelines.

4. References:

- Contact information (name and phone number) for three (3) professional or personal references who can speak to the nominee's contributions
