RE: Narcotics Search Warrant Executed at 13 East Main Street

On March 1st, at approximately 1412 hours, after a several month long investigation Detectives and Officers from the Webster Police Department executed a search warrant at 13 East Main Street, apartment 2R. In conjunction with the execution of the search warrant, a motor vehicle stop was conducted which resulted in the arrest of Patrick Evans, 43, same address. Also arrested was Amanda Angers, 34, 34 Park St #5 Webster, who was driving Mr. Evans at the time of the stop.

Both were charged two counts of Possession of a Class B substance, and two counts of Possession of a Class B Substance with the intent to distribute, Drug Violation near a school, and Conspiracy to violate the controlled substance law.

Evans was held on \$2040 cash bail at the Webster Police Department, Angers was released on \$540 and both are scheduled to be arraigned at Dudley District Court today.

Police confiscated 40 Xanax prescription pills, and just over 9 grams crack cocaine, both of which were packaged for distribution. Also small amount of cash was seized, as well as a replica handgun. Detective Sergeant James Hoover, Sergeant Toby Wheeler, Detective Chris Trainor, and Officer Spencer Donovan conducted the investigation and subsequent execution of the search warrant.
