RE: 28 grams of Heroin, cashed seized at park

Date: April 3, 2015

On 4/2/15 at approximately 1339 hours, the Webster Police received a phone call reporting that there was suspicious vehicle parked at the lower athletic field and it was being approached by multiple people. This was in the parking lot adjacent to the Ray Street Park. Police responded and subsequently arrested Mark McDonald 30, LKA 86 Center Rd. Dudley on outstanding warrants. Police also located over \$800 in cash as well as what appeared to be heroin packaged for sale, along with several different prescription type pills.

McDonald was the target of an active investigation by the Webster Detective Unit. It should be noted that all of the 28 grams was packaged for individual sale. Given the rise in overdoses, there is a strong likelihood that this large seizure may have prevented some. It was estimated to be about 60-70 individual bags, or doses.

Once back at the Webster Police Department, about 28 grams of heroin was located on Mr. McDonald. As a result McDonald was charged with the following:

Possession of a Class A, Class B, 3 Counts Class E Substance,

Possession of Class A with the Intent to Distribute

Trafficking in Heroin

Drug Violation near a School/Park

Dimitrios Gatsogiannis, 29, 19 Linwood St #2 Webster will be summoned into court for

Possession of a Class A substance, Possession of Class A with intent to Distribute, and Conspiracy to Violate the controlled drug law.

McDonald was held on \$5050 cash bail last night at the Webster Police Department. He will be arraigned to today at Dudley District Court.


