

RE: Drugs, gun, ammunition seized

After a several month long investigation, on 4/21/15 at about 1530 hours Detectives from the Webster Police Department, assisted by agents from the DEA task force based out of Worcester arrested two person for narcotic sales at the Market Basket parking lot in Oxford. Nicole Viestra, 30 85 North Main Street #2 Webster and Jesus Enrique Martinez, 24, 85 North Main Street #2 were taken into custody. Their two small children were with them and turned over to a family member. The Department of Children and Families was contacted and is conducting an investigation.

Following the arrest, a search warrant was executed at the residence where a 38 caliber firearm was recovered along with 190 rounds of various calibers, and a bullet proof vest. Approximately 4 grams of heroin, 50 different prescription type pills, and \$250 was seized.

Viestra was charged with the following:

- Possession of a Class A Substance
- Possession of a Class A Substance with intent to distribute
- 2 counts of distribution of a Class A substance
- Conspiracy to violate the controlled substance law
- Improper storage of a firearm
- Possession of a Class E Substance
- Possession of a Class C Substance
- Improper possession of ammunition
- Possession of a Firearm without an FID

Martinez was charged with the following:

- Possession of a Class A Substance
- Possession of a Class A Substance with intent to distribute
- 6 counts of distribution of a Class A substance
- Conspiracy to violate the controlled substance law
- Improper storage of a firearm
- Possession of a Class E Substance
- Possession of a Class C Substance
- Improper possession of ammunition
- Possession of a Firearm without an FID

Viestra was held on \$1040 cash bail last night at the Webster Police Department
Martinez was held on \$2540 cash bail last night at the Webster Police Department
Both parties will be arraigned at the Dudley District Court
