RE: Charges filed in Motor vehicle crash

On March 22 at 2145 hours, The South Worcester County Communications Center received numerous calls reporting a multi car accident on Granite Street in which two males were seen running from the area. Officer Spencer Donovan arrived and discovered a motor vehicle later believed to be driven by Dimitrios Gatsogiannis, 33, 19 Linwood St Webster, caused significant damage to three other cars by hitting one and forcing into the other two.

Gatsogiannis was later located and transported to Harrington Hospital at the Hubbard campus in Webster with serious injuries. The Central Massachusetts Law Enforcement Council Crash Reconstruction Team was activated and is conducting the reconstruction of the crash.

Gatsogiannis has been summoned to court for the following:

- OUI Liquor
- Negligent Operation
- Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident
- Speeding
- Disorderly Conduct
- Disturbing the Peace

The passenger, Daniel Orlowski, 31, 114 Fabyan Rd, North Grosvenordale Ct. is also being summoned to court for:

- Disorderly Conduct
- Disturbing the Peace

There is also an outstanding warrant for Orlowski's arrest for an unrelated charge.

They will be arraigned at a future date at Dudley District Court.
